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Contract / Random Ice

Skaters Rules and Responsibilities

1. At the beginning of the freestyle session, the skater must check in with the Rink Supervisor stating your name and handing in your music. It is your responsibility to find the Rink Supervisor. If you cannot find the Rink Supervisor, please ask your pro or parent to check in the book to find out who is the Rink Supervisor for that session.
2. Generally, music will be played on a first come, first served basis. In the event that the session is full and many skaters wish to play their program music, skaters may only have one CD or track in line at a time, and may not play the same CD or track, or a different CD or track, until all other skaters' music in line has been played.
3. When it is your turn, please be prepared to skate your program. Music will only be stopped and restarted at the discretion of the Rink Supervisor.
 - a. The Rink Supervisor will announce the skater's name before their program music so other skaters are aware of who is skating their program.
 - b. When the skater performing their program is announced, the next skater to skate their program is also announced so the skater can put on a sash and be ready.
 - c. The skater is required to visibly wear the fluorescent colored sash while skating their program.
 - d. The skater wearing the sash has the right of way.
4. Random ice buyers must pay immediately upon entering the ice. Checks or punch cards only, no **cash or credit**. \$13.00 (or 4 punches) for a 1 hour Freestyle session, \$9.75 (or 3 punches) for a 45 minutes session, of \$15.00 for an Ice Dance session with a lesson (\$13.00 without a lesson). Skaters will be asked to leave the ice if they do not have payment.
5. If a skater's name isn't typed in on the attendance list, that skater may not go on the ice. The Rink Supervisor must write their name in the Random Ice Buyers Journal with a question mark and collect the appropriate fee for that session. These fees will be returned once the contract session is verified. The skater or parent must notify Kelly Fischbach at (651)733-5941 or Linda Napoli at (651)773-7024 for the claim.

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Contract / Random Ice

Safety Contract

1. Respect the rights of other skaters.
2. No food, gum, or beverages (except plastic bottles of water) are allowed on the ice by skaters or coaches. No cell phones or personal music devices are allowed on the ice.
3. Skates must be worn on the ice – no street shoes or boots.
4. Skaters and/or Pros should not stand on the ice in the way of other skaters who are working. If you need to rest, go to the hockey box or off the ice. Do not sit on the boards or sit or lay on the ice. For short rests on the ice, stand with your back against the boards and away from the corners.
5. All skaters **MUST** be alert for fellow skaters on the ice to avoid collisions. Watch where you and others are going at all times. If a fall occurs, do your best to immediately get up and go to the side.
6. Watch for skaters executing jumps, spirals, camel spins, etc. Spins can only be practiced on the harness end of the rink between the blue line and the boards. Jumps should be executed from the same blue line to the other end of the rink. These rules do not apply when practicing your program.
7. When a skater is skating their program, the following rules apply:
 - a. The Rink Supervisor will announce the skater's name before playing their program music so other skaters and Pros are aware of which skater is skating their program.
 - b. The skater is required to wear the colored sash (clearly visible) while skating their program.
 - c. The skater with the sash has the right of way.
8. Skaters may use the jumping harness **ONLY** with the supervision of their Pro.
9. When the Rink Monitor announces the end of the session, skaters and Pros must clear the ice immediately.

2010 Maplewood Fall Classic Volunteer Policy
