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## Volunteer Requirements

We are requiring a **minimum** volunteer effort of 2 shifts per family (plus 1 additional shift for each additional skater) at the Maplewood Fall Classic Competition, September 15<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at the Vadnais Heights Sports Complex. This is a requirement for all full members, **regardless if your skater is competing at the competition**. Members who have not completed the balance of their required volunteer hours by September 18<sup>th</sup>, will be billed a volunteer fee of \$100 (plus an additional \$50 per additional skater). The skater(s) shall be deemed “not in good standing” with US Figure Skating, and shall not be allowed to skate on club ice, compete, participate in synchro practice or competitions, test with US Figure Skating, renew their US Figure Skating Membership with any club, or participate in any club benefits afforded by their membership until such a time as all outstanding bills are paid.

I agree to fulfill the mandatory volunteer requirements as stated above. I understand and agree that I will be invoiced \$100 (plus \$50 for each additional skater) for unfulfilled shifts. \_\_\_\_\_ **(Initial here)**

We will be enforcing our late payment policy for all areas of the Maplewood FSC. It is as follows:

- **Payments 30 days late** – a \$20 late fee will be assessed.
- **Payments 60 days late** – skater will not be allowed on MFSC ice, or to participate in any competition or test session.
- **Payments 90 days late** – skater will be removed from the MFSC roster and registered as a member not in good standing with US Figure Skating. To be reinstated, you will need to re-submit your membership packet with a \$110 reinstatement fee.

## Contract / Random Ice

### Skaters Rules and Responsibilities

1. At the beginning of the freestyle session, the skater must check in with the Rink Supervisor stating your name and handing in your music. It is your responsibility to find the Rink Supervisor. If you cannot find the Rink Supervisor, please ask your pro or parent to check in the book to find out who is the Rink Supervisor for that session.
2. Generally, music will be played on a first come, first served basis. In the event that the session is full and many skaters wish to play their program music, skaters may only have one CD or track in line at a time, and may not play the same CD or track, or a different CD or track, until all other skaters' music in line has been played.
3. When it is your turn, please be prepared to skate your program. Music will only be stopped and restarted at the discretion of the Rink Supervisor.
  - a. The Rink Supervisor will announce the skater's name before their program music so other skaters are aware of who is skating their program.
  - b. When the skater performing their program is announced, the next skater to skate their program is also announced so the skater can put on a sash and be ready.
  - c. The skater is required to visibly wear the fluorescent colored sash while skating their program.
  - d. The skater wearing the sash has the right of way.
4. Random ice buyers must pay immediately upon entering the ice. Checks or punch cards only, no **cash or credit**. \$15.00 (or 4 punches) for a 1 hour Freestyle session, \$11.25 (or 3 punches) for a 45 minutes session, of \$18.00 for an Ice Dance session with a lesson (\$15.00 without a lesson). Skaters will be asked to leave the ice if they do not have payment.
5. If a skater's name isn't typed in on the attendance list, that skater may not go on the ice. The Rink Supervisor must write their name in the Random Ice Buyers Journal with a question mark and collect the appropriate fee for that session. These fees will be returned once the contract session is verified. The skater or parent must notify Joyce Schwartz at (651)748-1619 or Dawn Ryan at (651)770-8180 for the claim.

## Contract / Random Ice

### Safety Contract

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1. Respect the rights of other skaters.
2. No food, gum, or beverages (except plastic bottles of water) are allowed on the ice by skaters or coaches. No cell phones or personal music devices are allowed on the ice.
3. Skates must be worn on the ice – no street shoes or boots.
4. Skaters and/or Pros should not stand on the ice in the way of other skaters who are working. If you need to rest, go to the hockey box or off the ice. Do not sit on the boards or sit or lay on the ice. For short rests on the ice, stand with your back against the boards and away from the corners.
5. All skaters MUST be alert for fellow skaters on the ice to avoid collisions. Watch where you and others are going at all times. If a fall occurs, do your best to immediately get up and go to the side.
6. Watch for skaters executing jumps, spirals, camel spins, etc. Spins can only be practiced on the harness end of the rink between the blue line and the boards. Jumps should be executed from the same blue line to the other end of the rink. These rules do not apply when practicing your program.
7. When a skater is skating their program, the following rules apply:
  - a. The Rink Supervisor will announce the skater's name before playing their program music so other skaters and Pros are aware of which skater is skating their program.
  - b. The skater is required to wear the colored sash (clearly visible) while skating their program.
  - c. The skater with the sash has the right of way.
8. Skaters may use the jumping harness ONLY with the supervision of their Pro.
9. When the Rink Monitor announces the end of the session, skaters and Pros must clear the ice immediately.

## 2011 Fundraiser and Policy

Dear Club Members,

Beginning this year we will be initiating a yearly mandatory fundraiser in addition to the Fall Classic volunteer requirement. The fundraiser will help to defray the cost of contract ice and therefore keep our membership fees and contract ice down. The addition of a fundraiser in addition to volunteer requirements is also in line with policies across many, if not all, of the Figure Skating clubs throughout the Twin Cities.

We will be selling "Coupon Cards" giving great discounts on products and services from local businesses. These offers represent ongoing discounts to popular local restaurants, car washes etc. There is a portion of the fold out sheet that advertises our club and the skate school, and the rest is devoted to a variety of coupons and offers. The cards will sell for \$20 each, and of that \$20 the club will make \$11 profit. The requirement will be to sell **10 cards**. For multiple skater families, the requirement will be 10 cards for the first skater, and 5 cards for each additional skater.

The cards will be distributed July 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, and more details regarding the distribution will be forthcoming. Each member must pick up their cards on one of these days. The deadline for selling the cards will be **July 29<sup>th</sup>**. At that time, one of the following will occur:

- The club will return your \$200 check upon receiving checks for your 10 cards amounting to \$200.
- If the amount of cards sold is less than 10, the club will accept the checks for the cards that have been sold, deposit your \$200 check, and write you a check for the amount sold upon your check clearing.

If you sell 10 cards, and wish to sell more, more will be made available to you – just let Sue Persby know and you will be able to sign for additional cards. The revenue from these should be turned in at the end of the sale along with any unsold cards. Anyone selling 5 extra cards will receive a punch card for buying on to contract ice (\$60 value). **We will also be rewarding the top two card sellers with \$100 gift cards.**

As mentioned above, details regarding where and at what time on July 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> the card distribution will occur will be emailed to you.
