



The following safety sheet has been created to share important information to keep all participants and instructors safe. Please make sure you read this document carefully to understand the new expectations and requirements for all.

### **OVERALL SKATE SCHOOL MODIFICATIONS**

- There will be no practice time – all classes will be 30 min
- Instructors will adjust lesson plans to allow as much social distancing as possible
- Number of skaters on the ice has been reduced
- Masks are required for all inside the arena (skaters, parents and instructors)
- Skaters and Instructors MAY remove face mask on the ice during class time
- On ice/class tools such as balls and toys will be limited. If used, we will ensure proper cleaning/sanitizing of items
- Always be mindful of social distancing
- Please wash hands frequently and use provided hand sanitizer
- PLEASE stay home if not feeling well

### **ARRIVAL**

- Skaters will be allowed to enter building 10 min before class begins – look for ENTER ONLY sign
- There will be a check in table to receive name tag, these are sanitized after every use
- Masks are required for all inside the arena (skaters, parents and instructors)
- Skaters should come fully dressed and ready to skate, there will be limited space to put skates on. If you have hard guards and able to enter with skates on that would be preferred as well

### **SPECTATOR (Parent/Guardian) INFORMATION**

- Skaters may be dropped off and picked up (we have cell phone numbers for all parents from registration)
- If a parent/guardian wishes to stay during class, only **ONE** parent/guardian is allowed in the arena with the skater.
- Parent or guardian will need to remain in stands during class. Social distancing is REQUIRED and are REQUIRED to wear a mask the entire time in the arena.

### **DEPARTURE**

- Skaters and Parent/Guardians are asked to leave the arena as soon as lessons are completed. Skates may be removed but please do any undressing of clothing in the car/parking lot
- Look for EXIT ONLY sign to exit arena

### **COMMUNICATION**

- Communication will be sent via email (to the email entered at time of registration) to let participants know of any changes, updates or needed information.
